Oklahoma School Immunization Requirements & Exemption Information

What Families Need to Know

Oklahoma state law (**70 O.S. §1210.191**) requires all students enrolling in public schools to provide either:

- A current immunization record** showing required vaccines, **or**
- A state-approved exemption certificate** completed through the Oklahoma State Department of Health (OSDH).

Students must have one of these on file **before attending school**.

Required Immunizations for Grades Pre-K–6

(Minimum number of doses for most students)

- **DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis):** 5 doses
- **Polio (IPV):** 4 doses
- **MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella):** 2 doses
- **Hepatitis B:** 3 doses
- **Hepatitis A:** 2 doses
- **Varicella (Chickenpox):** 1 dose or proof of disease

Requesting an Immunization Exemption

If your family seeks a medical, religious, or personal exemption, you may apply through the **Oklahoma Immunization Exemption Portal**:

Steps to complete your exemption:

1. Visit the portal link above and create an account.
2. Complete the exemption application online.
3. Once approved (typically within 1–3 business days), download and print your **exemption certificate**.
4. Provide the signed certificate to the school office.

Important Reminder

During a disease outbreak, students without up-to-date immunizations or valid exemptions may be temporarily excluded from school until it is safe to return.
